THE END OF SINE DIE 2021

Nevada has made it to the final stretch in the 81st Legislative session and bills have landed on the the Governor Sisolak's desk!

We are elated to announce AB349 passed the Nevada Senate by 12-9 Monday!! This is the bill sponsored by Assemblyman Howard Watts that closes the "classic car" loophole, reduces smog pollution, improves public health, helps low-income Nevadans access cleaner cars, and fights climate change!

Another important clean energy bill <u>SB448</u> sponsored by Senator Chris Brooks was moved forward by State lawmakers with a 32-10 vote. This bill will mandate the utility to invest \$100 million in electric vehicle charging stations and other policy adaptations to elevate the carbon reduction agenda in Nevada.

AB116 sponsored by Assemblywoman Rochelle Nguyen that decriminalizes traffic tickets came out with a big win with a 20-1 vote in the Senate. As it's previously been, minor traffic offenses turned into warrants, and would lead to arrests; punishable by up to six months in jail. This bill would make traffic violations civil infractions; without the worry of being given jail time!

Another highly debated bill sponsored by Assemblymen Steve Yeager that had previously been pushed back and now passed 17-3 was AB341. Previously individuals of legal age were not allowed to consume cannabis anywhere outside of a private residence. This bill authorizes cannabis consumption lounges for people to legally consume marijuana.
